

MINUTES OF THE STATE LEVEL EXPORT PROMOTION COUNCIL (SLEPC) COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 16TH DECEMBER 2010 AT 04:30 PM IN THE CHAMBER OF DEVELOPMENT COMMISSIONER, SECRETARIAT, MOTI DAMAN.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the participants. Leave of absence was granted to :

The Minutes for the last SLEPC committee meeting held on 1st September 2009 were approved.

The General Manager (ASIDE & IIUS Scheme) referred to the agenda items which were taken up accordingly. Progress of the work in various industrial estates of Daman and DNH was discussed by the committee members. The Chief Engineer informed about the details of work completed and status of work in progress as mentioned bellow.

- a. **Siddhivinayak Industrial Estate** : Road side drainage work from Cello House to Goa IDC at Somnath, Nani Daman, admeasuring length 210 meter and width of 1.50 meter costing ₹9,03,409.99 has been completed.
- b. **Golden Industrial Estate** : Road side drainage work admeasuring length 992 meter and width of 1.50 meter costing ₹39,37,138.55 has been completed.

c. Daman Industrial Estate :

- i) Road side drainage work from temple to coastal highway at Dalwada, Nani Daman admeasuring length 735 meter and width of 1.50 meter costing ₹25,72,155.71 has been completed.
- ii) Road side drainage work from Vraj Packaging upto coastal highway, from Wel-tuff to coastal highway and from coastal highway to M/s. Polycab and M/s. Radha Madhav admeasuring total length 2002 meter and width of 1.50 meter is in progress. 50% work has been completed. The total estimated cost for this work is ₹1,30,40,998.49.

Road work in Daman

a. **Siddhivinayak Industrial Estate :** Upgradation of Road from Cello House to Goa IDC at Somnath, Nani Daman, admeasuring length 350 meter and width of 10.00 meter costing ₹43,75,645.76 has been completed.

b. Golden Industrial Estate :

- i) **Part – I** Upgradation of Road admeasuring length 400 meter and width of 10.00 meter costing ₹50,00,913.23 has been completed.
- ii) **Part – II** Upgradation of Road admeasuring length 190 meter and width of 08.00 meter costing ₹26,94,709.07 has been completed.

c. Daman Industrial Estate :

- i) Upgradation of Road from temple to coastal highway at Dalwada, Nani Daman admeasuring length 890 meter and width of 10.00 meter costing ₹1,09,29,157.72 has been completed.
- ii) Construction of concrete road from Jain Parmar Electronic towards Oriental Packaging Ltd to Unimin Ind. Pvt Ltd, from village road towards Unimin Ind. Pvt Ltd and from Blow Pack Pvt Ltd to Suzlon Energy Ltd., Daman total admeasuring 1272 meter and width of 08.00 meter costing ₹1,44,06,778.08 has been completed.
- iii) Construction of concrete road Vraj Packaging upto coastal highway, from Wel-tuff to coastal highway and from coastal highway to M/s. Polycab and

M/s. Radha Madhav admeasuring total length 1001 meter and width of 8.00 meter costing ₹1,32,24,808.08 has been completed.

Road Work in Dadra and Nagar Haveli.

Construction of concrete road at Piparia Industrila Estate admeasuring length of 900 meter and width of 8.00 meter costing ₹1,26,99,856.50 has been completed.

Third party audit : The Chief Engineer informed that third party audit of all Road work has been carried out. The same was noted by the committee members.

Fund Availability : It was informed that fund of ₹1,05,97,115.00 is available under the ASIDE Scheme for Daman & Diu whereas the fund available for Dadra and Nagar Haveli is ₹65,53,389.71.

Pending Requests :The Chief Engineer mentioned requests for work have been received from Silver Industrial Estate and Bhenslore Industrial Estate. Accordingly, it was decided to take up new work for Silver Industrial Estate and Bhenslore Industrial Estate. It was emphasized that requisite proportionate contribution from the Industry associations should be recovered for carrying out these works.

The Development Commissioner directed that meetings with the various industry associations may be held to explore the possibility of taking up new projects for up-gradation of new industrial estates under ASIDE Scheme on a 50: 50 contribution basis. The Managing Director OIDC was authorized to do the needful in this regard.

The Development Commissioner also instructed that the Minutes of the SLEPC Committee meeting should be placed on the website of OIDC and the website of the Ministry of IPP.

There being no other item / business, meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
